Title of Event:- **2 Day Charity Road Taxed Vehicle Team Trial (26th. & 27th. June 2010)**

Supplementary Regulations

The Wye and Welsh LRC will organise a Clubsport status **RTV Trial** on **Saturday 26th. & Sunday 27th. June 2010 at Maeslech Farm, Radyr, near Cardiff, South Wales**. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd. (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) , the Association of Land Rover Clubs and these Supplementary Regulations.

An MSA Permit has been applied for.

The event is open to all fully elected members of the participating ALRC clubs in teams of 3.

All competitors must produce a valid ALRC Club Membership Card.

Valid MOT and Tax disc for the vehicle must be shown at scrutineering.

Tow ropes and tow points must be to minimum ALRC regs. and will be checked.

Seat belts should be worn as designed.

The programme of the meeting shall be:

Signing on and Scrutineering **1700hrs – 2030hrs** Friday 25th. and **06:30 hrs- 0800hrs** Saturday.26th.

Marshals briefing at **08:15 Saturday**, Drivers briefing at **08:30 Saturday**, First vehicle starts **09:00 Saturday**.

Drivers briefing **07:30 Sunday**, First vehicle starts **08:00 Sunday**.

The event will consist of 20 trial sections of various lengths marked by canes. (10 Saturday, 10 Sunday)

Site speed limit will be 10mph

Vehicle Regulations shall be as per the ALRC Regulations and MSA Technical Regulations.

To encourage the use of Standard RTV vehicles, each team member should compete in a class 1,2,3,4 or 5 ALRC vehicle.

W & W chief scrutineer's decision will be final on vehicle's class compliance.

Vehicles may be shared ie. double or triple driven.

Only one vehicle per team can be from the ALRC Modified classes ie.6,7,8,9,10 or 11. This modified vehicle may not be shared and if any team member's vehicle breaks down, then this modified motor cannot be shared.

Competition numbers shall be fixed to the sides of the vehicle.

The maximum entry shall be 150 competitors. (50 teams.)

Awards will be presented to the team of three drivers with the least penalty points over the 20 sections.

1st. overall to the team with the lowest penalties

2nd.overall to the team with the next lowest penalties

An award to the team consisting of all LWB vehicles, with the lowest penalties overall.

An award to the team consisting of all ladies, with the lowest penalties overall.

The entry list first opens on **1st.February 2010** and closes on **10th.June 2010**

The entry fee is **£120 per team**. (Cheques payable to 'Wye and Welsh Land Rover Club')

In the event of cancellation, fees will be refunded. (Minus £20 administration costs & charity donation.)
